The present writ petition has been filed for a direction to respondents concerned to grant Double Accident benefit to the petitioner whose father was died (Policy holder) in a road accident. The deceased having two policies of L.I.C. in his name and without any cogent reason the same was not paid to the petitioner, who is the nominee of both the policies.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly accepts that alternative remedy by approaching the Consumer Forum is available to the petitioner, which has not been availed.



3. In the above view of the matter, the writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Consumer Forum for redressal of his grievances in accordance with law.
