These matters involve a common issue and have been taken up together for disposal at the admission stage itself with consent of the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the appeals filed by the petitioners have since been disposed of in terms of the respective appellate orders as contained in Annexure-1 of each of
