ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The present application has been filed for modification of the order dated 12.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64418 of 2018, by which the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail in connection with Bodh Gaya (Cherki) P.S. Case No. 525 of 2018, pending in the court of learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya and the petitioners were directed to surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks and furnish bail bond.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioners could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is prayed on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the father's name of



petitioner no. 2 in the order dated 12.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64418 of 2018 be read as 'Ram Sharan Manjhi' in place of 'Late Rameshwar Manjhi'. It is further submitted that further time may be extended so that the petitioners could surrender in the court below and furnish bail bond.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioners and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the father's name of petitioner no. 2 in the order dated 12.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64418 of 2018 be read as 'Ram Sharan Manjhi' in place of 'Late Rameshwar Manjhi' and the period of surrender of the petitioners in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 12.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64418 of 2018, is modified to the extent as indicated above.
