5 09-05-2018 This is a very unfortunate case where despite the orders dated 7.9.2017, 14.9.2017 and 19.3.2018 the respondents have failed to comply with the orders of this Court and consequently, no counter affidavit has been filed. By way of last indulgence, on 19.3.2018, four weeks' time was granted to the respondents to file counter-affidavit and it was made clear that if no counter-affidavit is filed, the present writ petition would be disposed of on the basis of the materials on record and the averments made in the writ petition. Today also, there is no response on behalf of the respondents inasmuch as no counter affidavit has been filed.



In such view of the matter, this Court is left with no option, but to set aside and quash the order passed by the District Magistrate, Gaya dated 6.2.2016 by which the petitioner has been put under suspension.

The writ petition is allowed.
