3 24-07-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

In view of the fact that the Bihar Staff Selection Commission has invited objection from the eligible candidates for preparation of the select list to fill-up the left over vacancies, no further indulgence is required.
