The learned counsel for the respondent-State

points out that the order dated 12.03.2016 passed by the District Education Appointment Appellate Tribunal, Saran at Chapra is required to be challenged before the State Appellate Authority and not before this Court, hence the present case is not maintainable on account of availability of alternative remedy.
