This Criminal Appeal has been filed against the

judgment dated 13.10.2017 passed in Session Trial no. 129 of

2013, 402/14 and 158/14 by which and whereunder the learned

court below acquitted the respondent nos. 2 to 6 of the charges

whereas convicted 14 accused persons.



Submission on behalf of the appellant is that the learned court below acquitted the respondent nos. 2 to 6 without any reason, particularly, in the circumstance when there was sufficient evidence to convict the respondent no. 2 to 6.

From perusal of the impugned judgment, we find that the learned court below well discussed the evidences on record and passed the impugned judgment of acquittal in respect of the respondent nos. 2 to 6. We do not find any ground to interfere into the impugned judgment of acquittal because the impugned judgment of acquittal does not carry any perversity and illegality.

Accordingly, this Criminal Appeal stands dismissed on admission stage itself.
