2. It appears that the grievance relates to fixation



of pensionary benefits in the scale of Rs.12000-16000/-, though the Accountant General has authorized the scale of Rs.10000-15200/-. From the pleadings, it appears that as per the Pay Revision Recommendation and the report of the Fitment Committee, the petitioner has been granted his pensionary benefits.

3. Having regard to the aforesaid and the fact that nobody has appeared to press the writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
