4 20-11-2018 The petitioner (proposed appellant) seeks grant
of leave against the judgment and order of acquittal dated
22.06.2017 passed by the learned Addl. Chief Judicial
Magistrate-III, Bhagalpur in connection with Trial No. 1442 of
2017 arising out of Complaint Case No. 964 of 2000.

After the framing of charge against the opposite
parties under Sections 147, 148, 504, 427, 380, 448 and 342



of the Indian Penal Code, no evidence was produced by the petitioner.

The opposite parties were examined under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and they denied the allegation. The Trial Court, therefore, acquitted the opposite parties of all charges.

No fault could be found with the aforesaid judgment and order of acquittal.

Leave is declined and the petition is dismissed.
