In the matter of appointment to Class-IV employees, the learned Writ Court has only remanded the matter back to the District Magistrate, Gopalganj to examine the service record of the respondent and take a decision without insisting upon production of an experience certificate.

In doing so, we are of the considered view that the learned Writ Court has not committed any error so grave in



nature that interference into the matter is called for.
