counsel for the State.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that his appeal bearing Case No. 43 of 2016 is pending before
the District Magistrate cum Collector, Rohtas at Sasaram. He
submits that as a result of pendency of the appeal his stolen
truck which was subject to the confiscation proceeding is
