Mithila University (hereinafter referred to as the 'University').

2. The petitioner has moved the Court seeking payment
of gratuity, unutilized earned leave and group insurance.

3. From the stand taken in the counter affidavit and
supplementary counter affidavit filed on behalf of the University, it
appears that gratuity and unutilized earned leave dues have been paid.

With regard to group insurance, learned counsel for the University has



taken a categorical stand before the Court, upon instructions from Mr. Saket, who is the person who is authorized to instruct learned counsel that the same has also been paid to the petitioner to the tune of Rs. 2,56,301/-.

4. In view thereof, the Court finds that the writ petition has served its purpose, and accordingly, the same stands disposed off.
