ORAL ORDER

2 12-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if they are permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 4 regarding their grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 4 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.



Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners may file a representation regarding their grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed before the respondent no. 4, then the same may be considered and disposed of within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order considering the fact that similarly situated employees have been granted the benefit of third A.C.P., who are even juniors to the petitioners.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
