Keeping in view the counter affidavits and the report submitted by the respondents, we are satisfied that for bringing into force the provisions of Section 8 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Rules, 1995, adequate statutory provision with offices and preventive measures have been put into place by the Government of Bihar and now if any of the authorities are not acting in accordance with law, specific instances may be brought to the notice of the Court and action would be taken as and when the aggrieved persons brings specific instances to the notice of the Court but



in this Public Interest Litigation, no further indulgence is required to be made.

In view of the action taken by the Government of Bihar, the writ petition stands disposed of.
