In case, petitioner files representation before the Vice-Chancellor of the University indicating therein the error in calculation and error in granting benefit including the amount of



Group Insurance, the respondent Vice-Chancellor will examine the claim of the petitioner objectively and pass reasoned and speaking order within a period of 60 days from the date of filing of representation along with a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
