This writ application is disposed off with a direction to the learned Special Judge, SC/ST, Aurangabad to ensure compliance of his order dated 17.03.2017 in the light of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P.** reported in **(2008) 2 SCC 409** which has been followed in the case of **Sudhir Bhaskarrao Tambe Vs. Hemant Yashwant Dhage** reported in **(2016) 6 SCC 277**.

If the order of learned Special Judge, SC/ST, Aurangabad has not been complied with and the matter is



brought to the notice of the court, the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned Police Station will be liable to be proceeded against for non-compliance with the order.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Aurangabad shall ensure that the order of the court of learned Special Judge, SC/ST, Aurangabad is complied with and proper investigation be conducted without further delay.

Accordingly, this application stands disposed off.
