3 21-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents.

The present application has been filed for modification of order dated 01.08.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 7046 of 2012 by which the writ petition was disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate



Authority against the order dated 28.02.2012 passed by the Member, District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, East Champaran at Motihari within a period of thirty days from the date of the order i.e. 01.08.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons, he could not prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority. Hence, he prays for further thirty days time to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority.

Considering the grounds mentioned in the application, the petitioner is granted further thirty days time to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority from today.
