2 08-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State as
well as University.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of
petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed representation
before the Vice-Chancellor of the J.P. University, Chapra for
redressal of his grievance on 12.03.2016, but no final decision on
the representation of the petitioner has been taken by the
respondent Vice-Chancellor. He further submits that this Court
may dispose of the writ application with a direction to the Vice-
Chancellor of the University to take final decision one way or the



other within a reasonable time.

Considering the aforesaid, the writ application is disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.5 (the Vice-chancellor, J. P. University, Chapra) to take final decision on the representation of the petitioner (Annexure-10) within a maximum period of 60 days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
