2 26-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been discriminated, whereas the similarly circumstanced other persons have been considered for regularization.

If the respondent-University is maintaining the stand of regularizing the services of non-teaching employees and if the petitioner stands on the similar footing and juniors have been regularized, the University is directed to give similar treatment to the petitioner. However, this court does not express any



opinion on the merit of the claim of the petitioner and it is for the University to consider and take decision on the entitlement of the petitioner for regularization. Decision in this regard must be taken expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
