Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner has been in custody since 19.12.2017 in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 174/2017 registered for the offences punishable under Section 341/323/325/307/504 of the Indian Penal Code. Later on, Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was added.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the present petitioner is not named in the First Information Report, yet in the subsequent statement, her name has been included as an afterthought. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no allegation of any specific overtact against the present petitioner and the allegations are general and omnibus in nature.



In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 174/2017.
