ORAL ORDER

3 27-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 07.12.2017 in connection with Patliputra P.S. Case No. 414 of 2017 for the offence registered under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and there has been no recovery from his conscious procession. It is further submitted, by means of supplementary affidavit, all that has been recovered from his possession are some pieces of silver and none of the items which are alleged to have been stolen has been recovered from his shop.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Judge- XII-cum-ACJM, Patna in connection with Patliputra P. S. Case No. 414 of 2017.
