ORAL ORDER

14 24-08-2018 Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties and considering the dispute more particularly in the show-cause and the earlier orders passed by this Court, this Court feels that there is no deliberate and wilful disobedience of any of the orders passed by the Court more particularly of the order of which non-compliance the present petition has been filed. There is serious dispute whether any amount was due or payable to the late employee or not. According to the respondents, the amount due and payable to the deceased employee was already paid while he was alive and



in fact one earlier contempt petition (M.J.C. No. 2017 of 2000)
was also disposed of on 16.10.2003 (Page-88).

Under the circumstances, the present application
stands dismissed.
