Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Kalyanpur P.S. Case No. 16/2018 registered for an offence
punishable under section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant of this case is S.H.O. of Kalyanpur
Police Station who on getting information about assembling of
accuseds, conducted raid in the house of the petitioner and other
co-accuseds. The petitioner was apprehended in his house and
one motor cycle was recovered. The petitioner did not produce
any paper showing its ownership. The other motor cycles were
recovered from two different places.



It has been submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the said motor cycle which was recovered from his house, as it was kept by one Manish Kumar who is co-villager. The said motor cycle has not been claimed by any owner to show that it is a stolen one. The petitioner is in custody since 02.02.2018 having clean antecedent.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on the other hand opposed the submission.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed and he is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No. 16/2018, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
