3 17-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Keoti
P.S. Case No. 171 of 2017 for offenses under Sections 302/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent. No injury was found on
the person of the deceased. In fact, deceased was suffering from
old ailment of TB and Asthma. He submits that at best the
instant case would be a case of culpable homicide not
amounting to murder.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and
the fact that the petitioners has remained in custody for nearly



six months and they have no criminal antecedent, let the petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga in connection with Keoti P.S. Case No. 171 of 2017.
