Heard the parties.

Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by this Court, vide order dated 10.7.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No24265 of 2017 on merit.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he is in custody since 28.3.2016 and up-till-now the trial has not been concluded.

Heard learned A.P.P. and the learned counsel for the informant..

From perusal of the report it appears that four witnesses have been examined and the case is pending for trial of the I.O., informant and other charge-sheet witnesses.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, however, the learned trial court is directed to conduct it on regular basis so as to conclude the trial as soon as possible without giving any unnecessary adjournment . At the same time, both the parties are directed to co-operate in disposal of the trial.
