4 13-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with Rasulpur P.S. Case No. 03 of 2018 registered
for the offences punishable under Section 304B/120B of the
Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against petitioner is torturing and
murder of niece of the informant due to non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case.
He is the father-in-law of the deceased. He is an old man aged
about 65 years. He has no criminal antecedent. He is in custody
since 12.01.2018.



Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Xth, Chapra, Saran in connection with Rasulpur P.S. Case No. 03 of 2018.
