ORAL ORDER

3 19-09-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Barhara P.S.Case No.94 of 2018 registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assault by '*Dabia*' to the informant causing injury to him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that there was dispute with respect to removal of pillar of the informant though the land belongs to the petitioner and the injury report has been issued by a private Doctor which shows that the injuries are grievous in nature. The petitioner is in custody for about 3 ½ years.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of ACJM –II, Purnea in connection with Barhara P.S.Case no.94 of 2018.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
