ORAL ORDER

3 05-09-2018 The petitioner is in custody since 07.12.2016 in connection with Fulwaria P.S. Case No. 137 of 2016, registered for offences punishable under Sections 302/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assaulting the father in law of the informant by means of fists, slaps and legs resulting in death of father in law of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that has been in judicial custody since 07.12.2016 and the evidence of informant has been recorded in this case, which clearly goes shows that she has not seen as to who assaulted the deceased. Moreover, there is allegation of assault only by fists and slaps.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the period of custody and also that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedent, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000, (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J -VIII, Gopalganj, in connection with Fulwaria P.S. Case No. 137 of 2016, with following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
