3 06-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
06.02.2017 in connection with Sessions Trial No. 111 of
2017/C.R. No. 111 of 2017, arising out of Bariyarpur P.S. Case
No. 14/2017 for the offence registered under Sections 25(1-B)a,
25(1-A), 25(1-AA), 25(1-AC), 26(1)(II), 35 of the Arms Act and
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that 159 Barrel, 158
half made pistol and some equipments of firearms alongwith 1.5
liters of foreign liquor were recovered from the vehicle.

This is fourth attempt on behalf of the petitioner for
grant of bail.



Earlier bail application of the petitioner was rejected vide Cr. Misc. No. 30813 of 2017 dated 07.07.2017, Cr. Misc. No. 50656 of 2017 dated 06.12.2017 and 17488 of 2018 dated 23.04.2018 taking into account that the petitioner was running a mini gun factory.

A report was called for from the court below regarding the stage of the case. It has been reported that out of 08 prosecution witnesses, 07 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and within a period of two months the trial is expected to be concluded.

Considering the nature of accusation and the stage of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is rejected in connection with Sessions Trial No. 111 of 2017, arising out of Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 14/2017, pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, 2nd, Munger.

The court below is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.
