learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in Mehasi P.S. Case No.
196/2017, instituted for the offences under Sections 304(B),
201/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 34 of D.P. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that
petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased.
There are general and omnibus allegation against them.

The petitioner is in custody since 03.05.2018.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances,
prayer of the petitioners for grant of bail is allowed. Let the
petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail
bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the



like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Mehasi P.S. Case No. 196/2017, subject to the conditions that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioners.
