**ORAL ORDER**

3      26-09-2018      Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Kahjauli P.S.Case No.13 of 2018 dated 2.2.2018, corresponding to G.R.No.198 of 2018, registered for offences punishable under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner, who happens to be mother-in-law, is of causing death of her daughter-in-law.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that no specific allegation has been attributed against the petitioner and she is aged about 70 years. The petitioner is in custody since 2.2.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of ACJM-III, Madhubani in connection with Kahjauli P.S.Case No.13 of 2018 dated 2.2.2018 corresponding to G.R.No.198 of 2018.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
