3 28-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Madaura P.S. Case
No.244/2018, registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 25(1-b)A, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against petitioner is that a loaded pistol has
been recovered from his possession.

It has been submitted that petitioner has falsely been
implicated in this case.

Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He is in custody
since 02.06.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-
named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond



of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate VIII, Saran at Chapra in connection with Madaura P.S. Case No. 244/2018, subject to the conditions:

- (1.) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2.) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be sufficient to cancel his bail bonds.
- (3.) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
