2. The petitioner has moved the Court for the following
reliefs:

*“(i) For issuance of a writ in the nature
of certiorari quashing the letter dated 10.07.2013
(Annexure-2) and 05.02.2014 (Annexure-3).*

*(ii) For issuance of any other
writ/order/orders to which the petitioner may be
found entitle in the fact and circumstances of the
case.”*

3. In view of the objection taken by learned counsel for
the Union of India, that for the relief claimed in the present writ
