ORAL ORDER

3 03-08-2018 The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kumarkhand P.S. Case No. 167 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 323, 354, 379, 307, 384, 386, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation as per F.I.R. is that petitioners and other accused persons demanded *Rangdari* and also assaulted the informant. Application against petitioner no.1 has already been dismissed vide order dated 03.07.2018.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that so far petitioner no.2 is concerned there is only allegation of assault by rod and injury is simple in nature and materials collected during the course of investigation shows that informant and petitioners are neighbour and counter version of the case is



also there.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioner no.2 above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura, in connection with Kumarkhand P.S. Case No. 167 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, as well as subject to the following conditions, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation and make themselves available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on their part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates



without showing any genuine reasons, the
prosecution is free to move for cancellation
of their bail bonds.
