ORAL ORDER

3 17-09-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Raniganj P.S.Case No.113 of 2017 registered for offences punishable under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner as per FIR is of snatching of Rs.45,000/- and Rs.75,000/- from the informant on the gun point and the petitioner is not named in the FIR and later on his name transpired during the course of investigation.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that there is no recovery from his possession and he is in custody since 2.2.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of CJM, Araria in connection with Raniganj P.S.Case No.113 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
