5 07-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 304B and 201/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The petitioner is father-in-law of the victim of
dowry death. Allegation is general and omnibus of commission of
torture for non-fulfillment of dowry demand by the in-laws
including the petitioner.

It appears that a compromise petition has been
filed in the court below, though the offence is not compoundable.

Considering the fate of the trial and the fact that
the petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2018 and investigation of
the case is already complete, let the petitioner, above named, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Baruraj Police Station Case No. 110 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner as well as condition that both the bailors shall be resident of within the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
