As none appeared on behalf of the petitioner the matter was passed over for a few cases. However, on repeat call the petitioner was again not represented.

2. The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order contained in memo no. 496 dated 17.06.2011 and memo nos. 1007 and 1026, both dated 20.09.2011 (Annexure-P1 series) issued by the Block Development Officer, Bairiya (Respondent No. 6) by which the petitioner has been directed to deposit rest amount of undistributed food grains lifted under the SGRY Scheme.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents appears and states that pursuant to the orders of this Court, the Enquiry Commission headed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Uday Sinha (Retired) has now submitted its report and any further action in relation to recovery of the value of



undistributed rice under the SGRY Scheme would abide by the decision of the State Government to be taken on the basis of such report.

4. Having regard to the stand of the respondents, the writ petition stands disposed of.
