ORAL ORDER

5 06-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

By filing supplementary affidavit, the petitioners have brought on record that they are accused in four more criminal cases. All are of trivial nature.

Submission is that all the cases were lodged by the same informant. Both sides are agnates. Allegation is of commission of assault including the outrage the modesty of the informant. The Doctor has found single injury on the person of the informant.



Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Supaul Mahila Police Station Case No. 74 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
