4 21-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Raxaul P.S. Case No. 169 of 2013 for the offence under
Sections 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
would submit that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The
name of the petitioner was disclosed by one Santosh Choudhary,
who submitted that the Laptop and Cellphone was handed over
to him by this petitioner, Vidya Sagar (not petitioner) and Bablu
Kumar (not petitioner). He further submits that petitioner has no
concern with the aforesaid cellphone and laptop which was
recovered from the possession of the Santosh Choudhary.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal



antecedent, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul, East Champaran in connection with Raxaul P.S. Case No. 169 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
