3 11-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Raushanganj
P.S.Case No. 110 of 2017 registered under Sections 120B and
304B of the Indian penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner
is in custody since 26.01.2017. It is submitted that in para 13
and 14 of case diary, witnesses have stated that deceased had
committed suicide by hanging. Learned counsel further submits
that trial has already proceeded and during trial, informant and
mother of deceased have not supported the case and
compromise has already taken place between the parties.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances, the
prayer of bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner,
abovenamed, is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing



bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Raushanganj P.S. Case No. 110 of 2017 with condition that petitioner shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court during trial and absence on two consecutive dates without valid reason, will result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner with condition that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner.
