This application was earlier listed on different dates under the heading for admission, but no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner to assist the Court. In the aforesaid circumstance, the case is listed today under the heading “For Dismissal” to provide one more opportunity to the petitioner to assist the Court, but no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner has filed the present writ application for a direction to the respondents to give appointment letter on the post of Assistant Teacher in Jehanabad, Nagar Parishad. The petitioner claimed that she has passed TET examination and also obtained Sahitya Alankar degree from Hindi Vidyapeeth, Deoghar.

3. The degree of Sahitya Alankar from Hindi



Vidyapeeth, Deoghar is recognized only for the purpose of proficiency in Hindi and it is not valid for appointment.

4. The issue with regard to validity of the degree of Sahitya Alankar from Hindi Vidyapeeth, Deoghar is no more *res integra*, as it has been decided by this Court and approved by the Apex Court.

5. In view of the above, the Court does not find any merit in the writ application. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
