4 11-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of murder of the sister of the informant is against unknown.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that even the available case diary would reveal that there is no substantial material against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned



Court below where the case is pending in connection with Udakishunganj Police Station Case No.72 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
