2 The writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioners' claim for regularization in light of the Resolution of the Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department dated 16.03.2006.

3 Petitioners, admittedly, have been disengaged as far back as in the year, 1990 itself. Respondents have filed specific



counter affidavit saying that they do not fulfill the requisite qualification under the scheme of regularization and they are not entitled to any consideration.
