ORAL ORDER

13 31-10-2018 In view of the statements made in the show cause showing that the entire subsistence allowance has been paid to the petitioner, the present contempt application has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not being paid the full salary of the said period during which he remained under suspension illegally.

In the opinion of this Court, such question cannot be



considered in the contempt jurisdiction if the same was not considered by the learned writ Court on earlier occasion. The petitioner will be at liberty to raise such issues in an appropriate application.

This application is dismissed as having become infructuous.
