Counsel for the petitioner is permitted to implead the
Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture as respondent no. 7.

2. As the statutory alternative remedy which is efficacious is
available to the petitioner, writ petition is disposed off with liberty to
the petitioner to make his appeal before the newly added respondent
no. 7 within a period of four weeks from today.

3. In the event such an application is filed, in view of the
objection regarding maintainability having been raised by the counsel
for the respondent, the time spent in the instant writ petition may not
be held against the petitioner. The Appellate Authority would be



obliged to consider the appeal of the petitioner without raising the issue of delay.

4. Let the appellate Authority consider and dispose off of the petitioner’s appeal by a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months thereafter.

5. Writ petition is disposed off.
