Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

2. Pursuant to order dated 19.09.2018, respondent no. 5 is present and has also filed show cause.

3. The reason why the respondent no. 5 was required to be present in Court has been detailed in the order dated 19.09.2018. The stand taken in the show cause is unqualified and unconditional apology for having taken a stand on oath which was contrary to the law settled by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Arvind Kumar Singh vs. State of Bihar reported as 2018(2) PLJR 933.**
