ORAL ORDER

3 20-06-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Khagaria (Muffasil) P.s.Case nO.683 of 2017 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 452, 323, 354(A), 307 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners and other accused persons is that they entered into the house of the informant and tried to drag the daughter of the informant and when he protested he was assaulted by the petitioner no.1 by *Dabia* on hand and there is also allegation of assault against petitioner no.2 and 3.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that there is case and counter case between the parties and the injuries are simple in nature.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Khagaria in connection with Khagaria (Muffasil) P.S.case No.683 of 2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioners will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioners shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make themselves available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
