If such representation is filed alongwith a copy of this order within a period of one month, the respondent no.6 is required to take final decision on such representation and decide the claim of the petitioner for payment of honorarium.

In case, the respondent no.6 finds substance in the claim of the petitioner for payment of honorarium, he will pass a reasoned and speaking order within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order and if it is found that the petitioner is entitled to monetary benefit, the same must reach the petitioner within a further period of two months from the date of such decision.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
