Short submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that those junior to the petitioner, on the ground of length of service in daily wages, have been considered, ignoring the case of the petitioner for regularization on Group D posts in the Collectorate, Sheohar. He submits that the petitioner has also filed representation (Annexure 4) before the District Magistrate/Collector, Sheohar (respondent no.3) in this regard.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to take a final decision on claim of the petitioner in accordance with law by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the date of



receipt/production of a copy of this order.
