ORAL ORDER

2 06-12-2018 In view of the fact that the State Government has constituted a Pradhikar under the *Bihar Anudanit Shikshan Sansthan Pradhikar Nimawali, 2015*, by notification No. 972 dated 19.5.2015 for adjudication of all kinds of disputes of *Anudanit Shikshan Sansthan*, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the *Pradhikar* constituted under the aforesaid rule within a period of one



month from today along with a copy of this order.

In the event such petition is filed by the petitioner before the *Pradhika* along with a copy of this order within a period of one month from today, the *Pradhikar* is required to dispose of the same in accordance with law after condoning the delay, if any, in filing such petition by a reasoned and speaking order and after hearing all concerned at the earliest preferably within a maximum period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
